Statement on the United States Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA)

Endress+Hauser products comply with the Toxic Substances Control Act. As required under the TSCA, certain substances and substance families are reportable or restricted from distribution in U.S. commerce, including:

- Dichloromethane (Methylene Chloride), for consumer paint and coating removal
- Dioxins

- Lead, when used in paint
- Mercury and Mercury Compounds
- Nitrites, when used in certain cutting fluids
- Polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs)

 - PIP (3:1), CAS 68937-41-7
 - DecaBDE, decabromodiphenyl ether, CAS 1163-19-5
 - 2,4,6 TTBP, 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl) phenol, CAS 732-26-3
 - HCBd, hexachlorobutadiene, CAS 87-68-3
 - PCTP, pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49-3
